**INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE ON
COBBLESTONES, AGED MARBLES,
SAND BLASTED, HAMMER ROUGHED
AND BUSH HAMMERED SURFACES.**

Antique look method:

Wash the surfaces using *SANNY KAL* diluted 10% or *CLEAN SPECIAL* or *DETERGON R3* diluted 5-10% rinse and when the floor is perfectly dry, apply a thin layer of *ANTIQUÉ MARBLE*, rub in and spread evenly using a white rag; the following day go over it with a single rotating brush polisher using a red or beige felt pad. The surface can be walked on after 3-4 days.

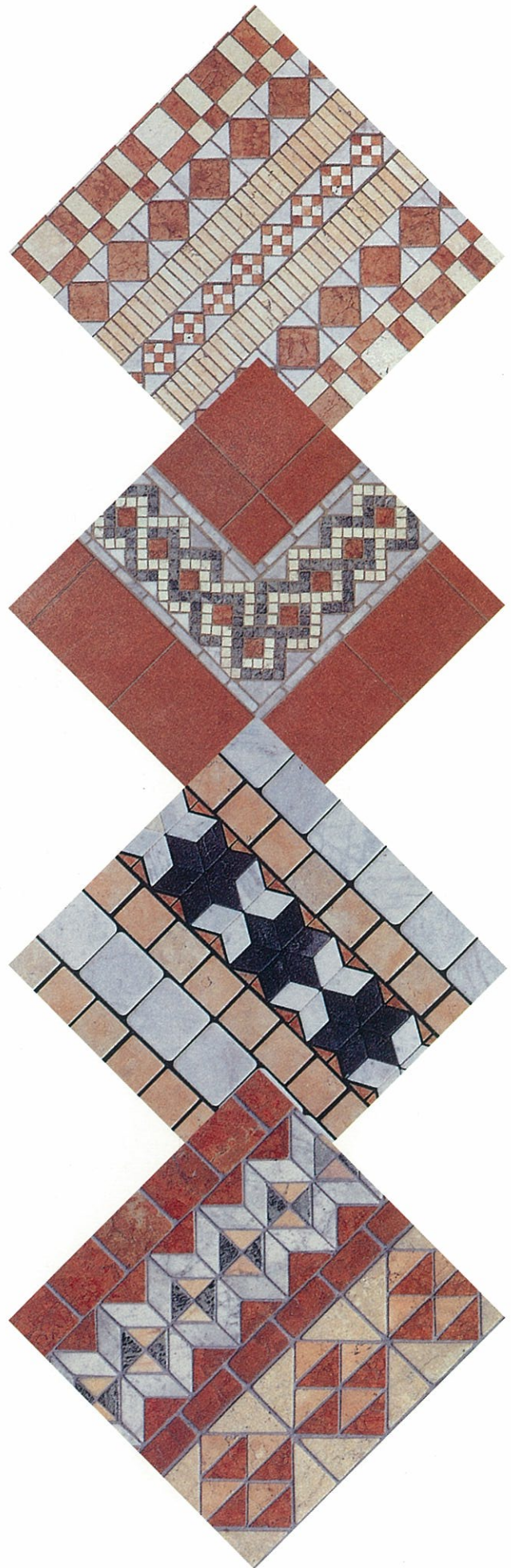
N.B.: The same treatment product can be used to maintain the surfaces when they have lost the antique satin finish effect because they have been walked on or detergents have been used to clean them. Dampen the cloth with *ANTIQUÉ MARBLE*, coat the surfaces evenly following the instructions for treatment.

Warnings:

ANTIQUÉ MARBLE can be used also simply to restore areas where pedestrians have worn away the treatment. Only one coat of the product should be applied both when treating and maintaining. We recommend you apply it lightly.

Satin-finish effect method:

Wash as instructed above, rinse, after 2-3 days (with pavement slightly damp) apply 1-2 coats of *FEDERCOTT/C* (neutral satin finish), leaving between 1-2 hours between each coat and then complete the treatment with a coat of *COVER*. The surface can be walked on after 1-2 days. To maintain the satin finish use a good water based wax polish, *LOOKING* for marble.
